FESTIVAL REGULATIONS

• Article 1 : dates and venues

The 8th Festival International du Film Ecologique will take place on 11th, 12th, 13th and 14th October 2012 at the Auditorium de Bourges
34, rue Henri Sellier - 18000 BOURGES - FRANCE

• Article 2 : participation requirements

> Theme: Ecology

> Year of film production:

Only films made from 2009 to 2012 will be selected

> Film categories:

Fiction films, documentary films, film reports

> Format:

Any kind accepted (very short, short and long films)

> Selection media:

DVD or Blu-Ray

> Projection media:

HD CAM (if not available HDV or Blu-Ray)

Please note : No other material will be accepted

Films in a foreign language must be sub-titled or dubbed in French.

• Article 3 : registration criteria

Film registration is entirely free

Registration is open until 15th may 2012.

To participate in the short-listing, applicants must provide:

> The registration form duly filled in and signed for each film

> The film in the selected medium (DVD or Blu-Ray)

• Article 4 : selection, competition, juries

The film selection jury is composed of 5 members. It is responsible for selecting films and informing the film-makers concerned. The jury decides on the films which will compete in the festival.

The organisers plan the projection of about 30 films, according to the length of the works.

Competing film makers will be festival guests. Selection for the 8th Festival International du Film Ecologique does not exclude participants from taking part in other events.

The award-giving jury is composed of 7 members, different from those on the selection jury. It is responsible for awarding prizes.

A high school jury composed of 10 members is in charge of high school award-giving.

The jury's choice is supreme, their decisions are irrevocable

• Article 5 : award-giving

The award-giving jury will present the film maker or his representative with the following awards:

> An award of 5000 € for the best fiction film

> An award of 5000 € for the best documentary film

> An award of 5000 € for the best film report.

> The best of the three award-winning films will be presented with the «GOLDEN TREE» award along with 5000 €

The high school jury will give an award of 2500 €

• Article 6 : rights

The festival requires producers or rightful owners to possess all the necessary intellectual property rights (copyright, performing rights, music copyright and publicity rights...), in view of the use of the films within the festival framework, exempt from royalties.

The producers or rightful owners of registered films authorise the festival organisers to use documents necessary for the media promotion of the film work (photos, texts, excerpts of 3 mins maxi...) without claiming royalties.

• Article 7 : film dispatch

Films are to be sent to the Agence Culturelle de Bourges. All costs (transport, insurance and customs duties) must be paid by the sender. Organisers will not be held responsible for any loss or damage relating to dispatches.

• Article 8 : acceptance of the regulations

Registration to the 8th Festival International du Film Ecologique implies full and entire agreement of the present regulations.
